Terms and conditions:

1. Only one entry per person.
2. Judges' decision is final.
3. Prizes will be awarded at the Mayor's reception and there is no cash alternative.
4. Proof of age may be required for under 18's.
5. Artwork must be supplied framed and ready to hang; size of artwork must not exceed A3 portrait or landscape format.
6. Artwork must be submitted with an entry form attached to the reverse of the artwork; any artwork supplied without an entry form attached will be disqualified and the Burford Festival cannot guarantee its safe return to the entrant.
7. Entries must be submitted to 175 The Hill, Windrush Court, OX18 4RE (Garage number 3), on Monday 11th May between 9-11am or 5-6pm.
8. Entries will not be accepted after this date.
9. Artwork not selected for exhibition as a finalist must be collected on 18th May 2026 from The Old Cottage Hospital, 57 Sheep Street, Burford OX18 4LS between 9-11am or 5-6pm. Non finalist artwork not collected may be disposed of after this date.
10. The exhibition will run from 2 weeks prior to the Festival and throughout the festival period (Festival starts 11th June - 23rd June 2026).
11. After the exhibition ends on Tuesday 23rd June, winners and finalists must collect their artwork between 10-12.00 on Monday 29th June from Warwick Hall. Artwork not collected on this date may be disposed of.
12. The Burford Festival, Festival organisers and Warwick Hall take no responsibility for the loss and / or damage of any artwork submitted.
13. By entering this competition the entrant acknowledges that, in the event that they win, their name and winning artwork may be used and shown by the Burford Festival for social media, hard copy media (newspapers, magazines) and other online and offline forms of media for perpetuity in connection with this art competition and the Burford Festival 2026.
